

## Application checklist for MultiDiverse <sup>1</sup>

- Proof of a B.A., B.Sc. or equivalent degree in Linguistics, Psychology, Cognitive Science, Educational Science, Sociology, Speech & Language Therapy or related subjects
- Documentation of advanced English language skills (at C1 or higher) <sup>2</sup>
- An academic CV in English in the Europass format which includes language skills
- An application letter in English (at most one page), indicating which university and which subject the applicant prefers for their Master's thesis
- Evidence of relevant work placements and other professional experience (optional)
- Two academic reference letters or one academic reference letter and one professional reference letter
- A copy of a valid identity card or passport showing the applicant's nationality; for students with multiple nationalities, a declaration stating the nationality under which they are submitting their application

<sup>1</sup> Documents that are not available in English, need to be translated into English and submitted along with the original versions.

<sup>2</sup> Applicants with a degree in a bachelor's or master's programme taught in English or who have attended an English-language secondary school do not have to document their English language skills.
